PARCC

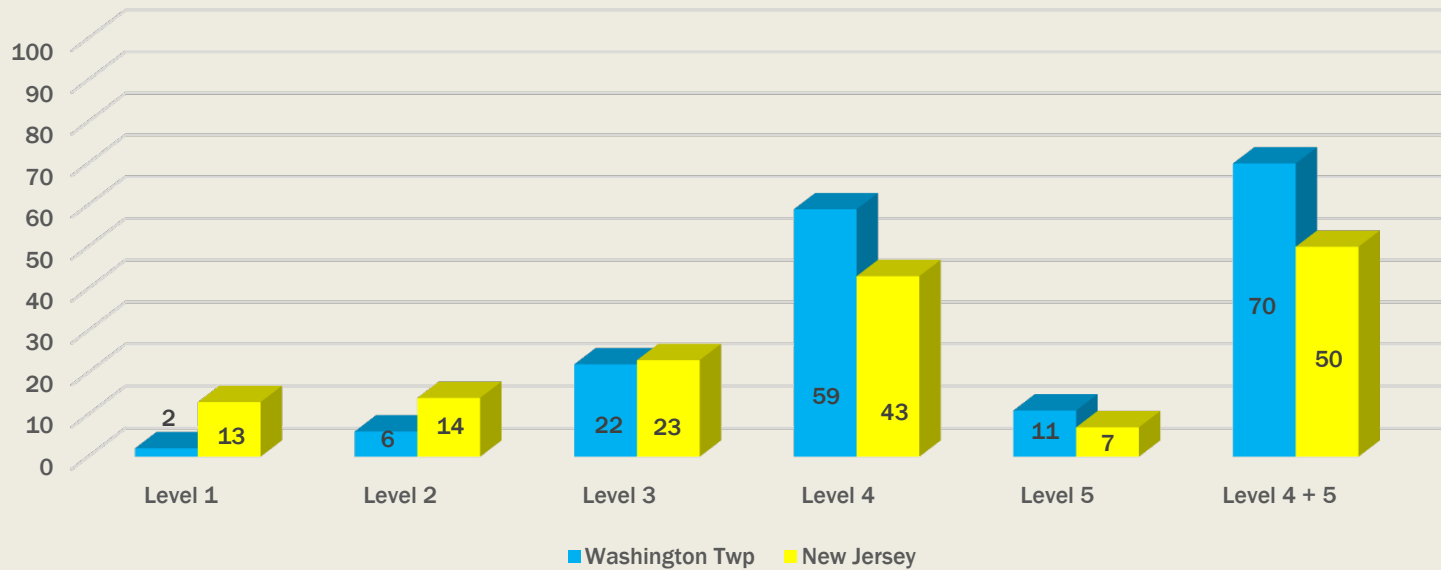
- **PARCC – Partnership for Assessment of Readiness for College and Careers:** is the New Jersey Assessment designed “to provide school with information to improve classroom instruction and to give parents valuable feedback about their child’s progress”.
- **Performance Levels – 5 Levels of Performance**
 - **Level 1 – Did Not Yet Meet Expectations**
 - **Level 2 – Partially Met Expectations**
 - **Level 3 – Approached Expectations**
 - **Level 4 – Met Expectations**
 - **Level 5 – Exceeded Expectations**
- **Levels 4 & 5 are considered “passing” for State reporting**

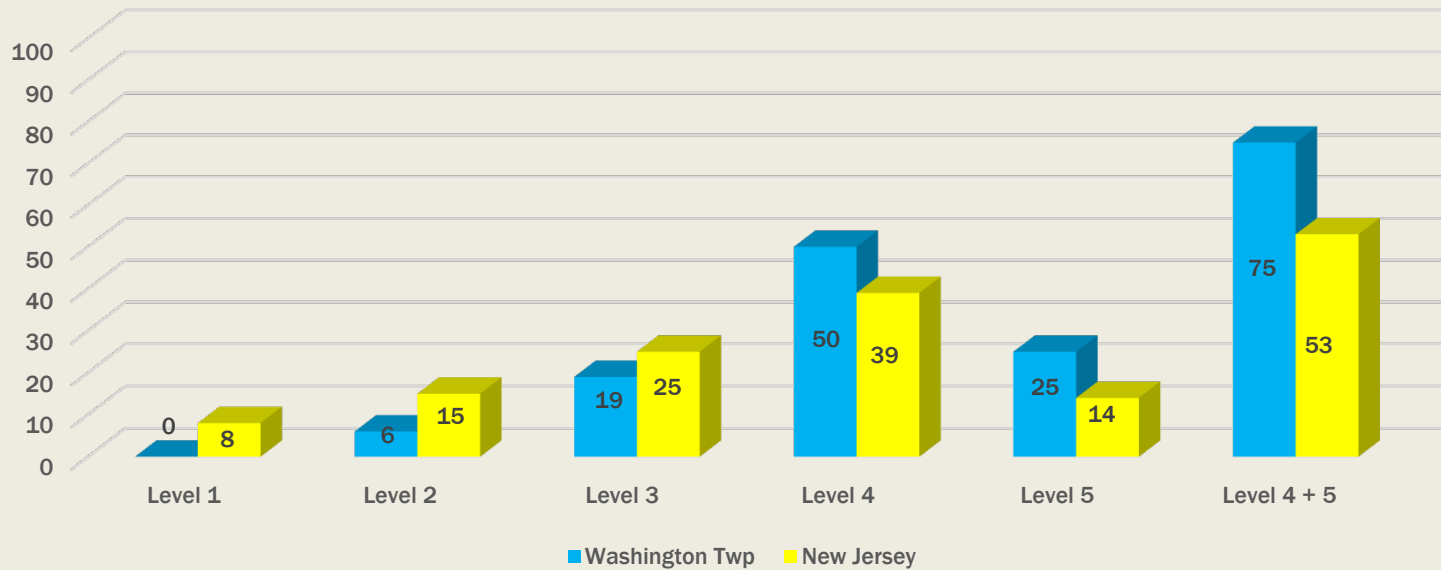

3rd Grade ELA - 2017



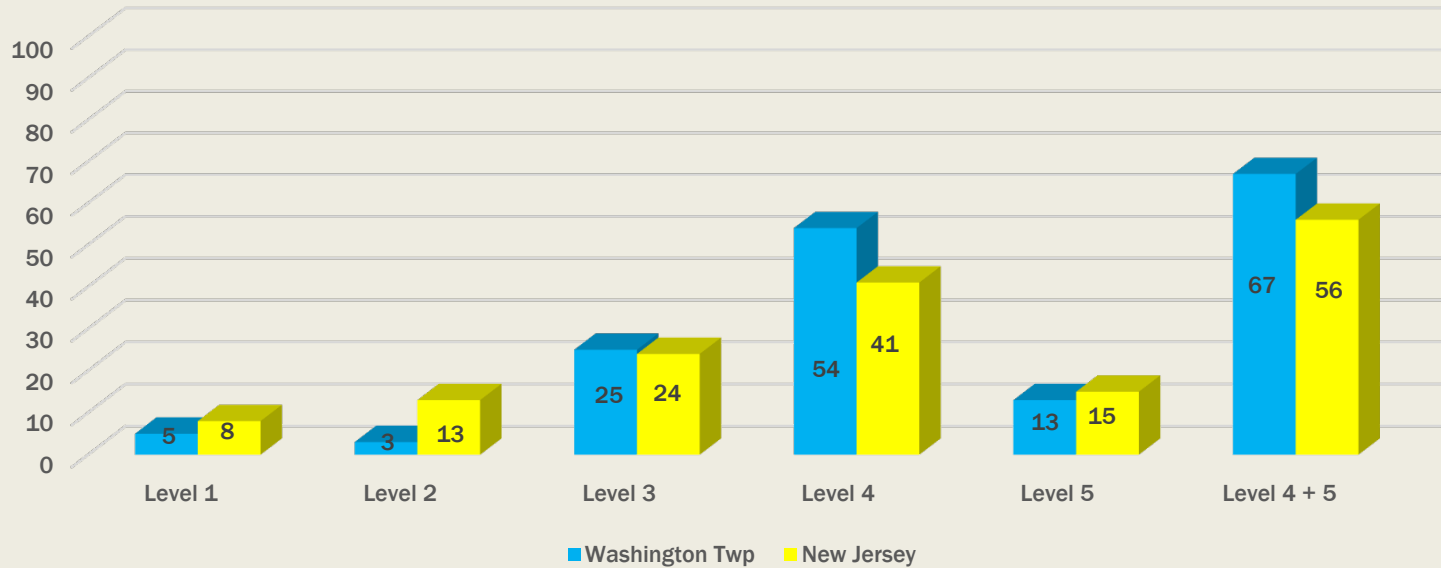
GRADE 3 - MATH

3rd Grade Math - 2017



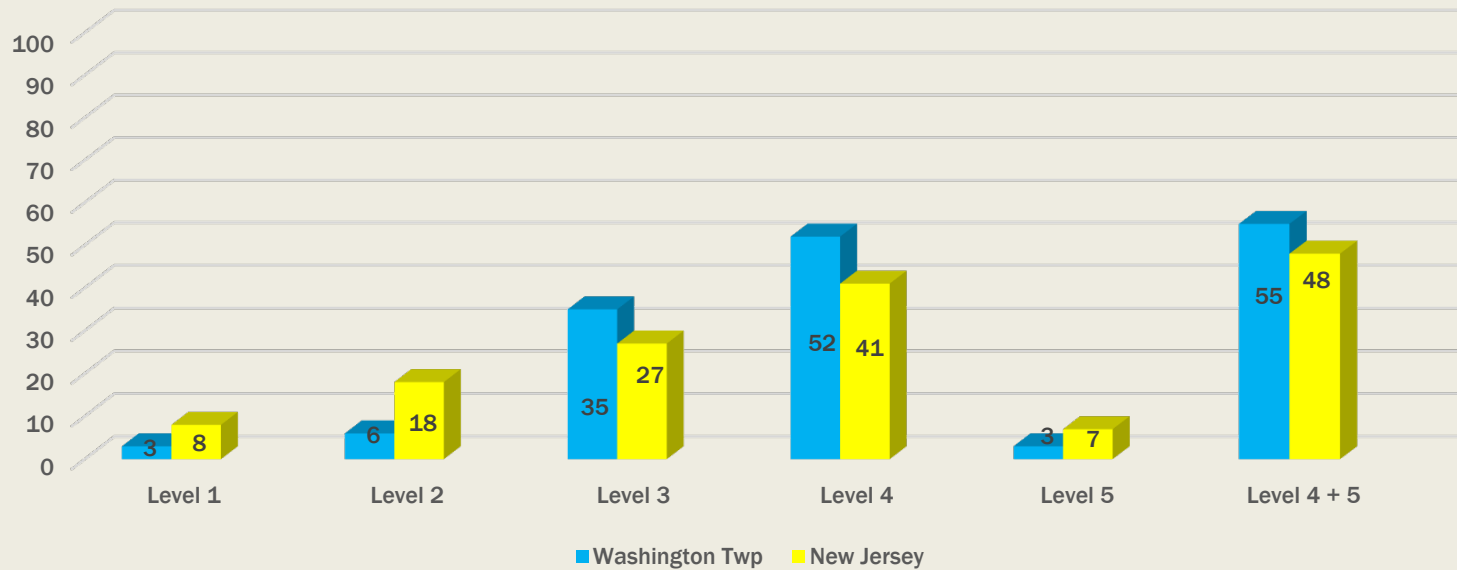

4th Grade ELA - 2017



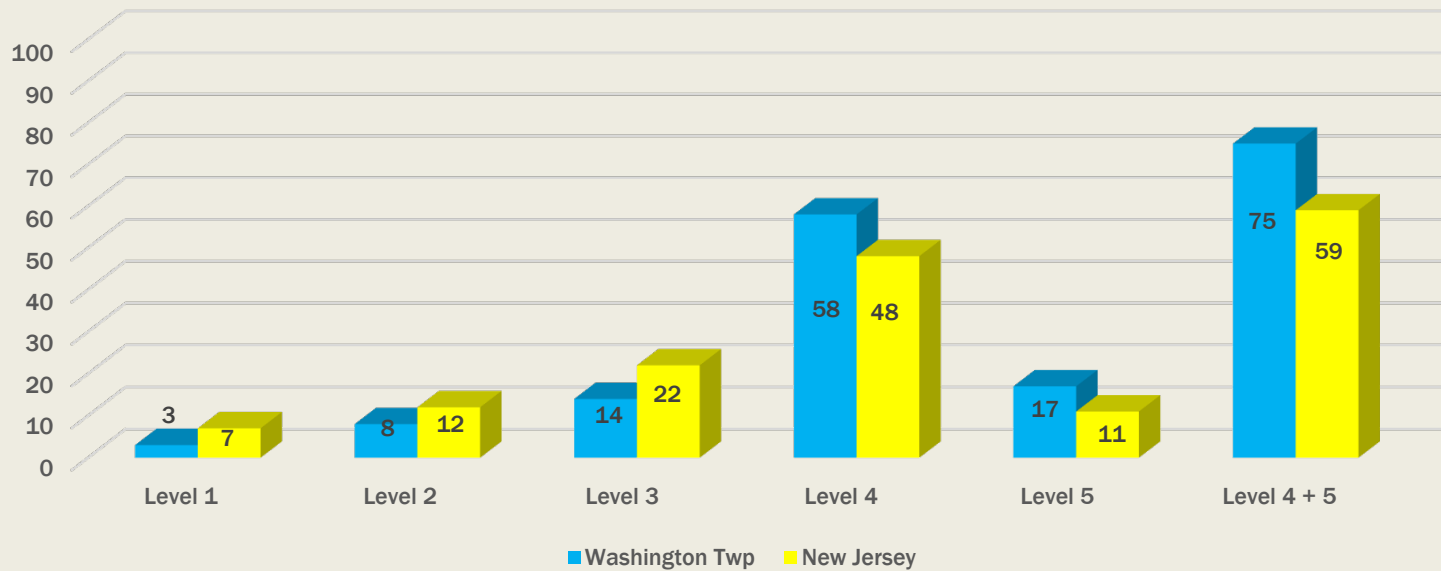

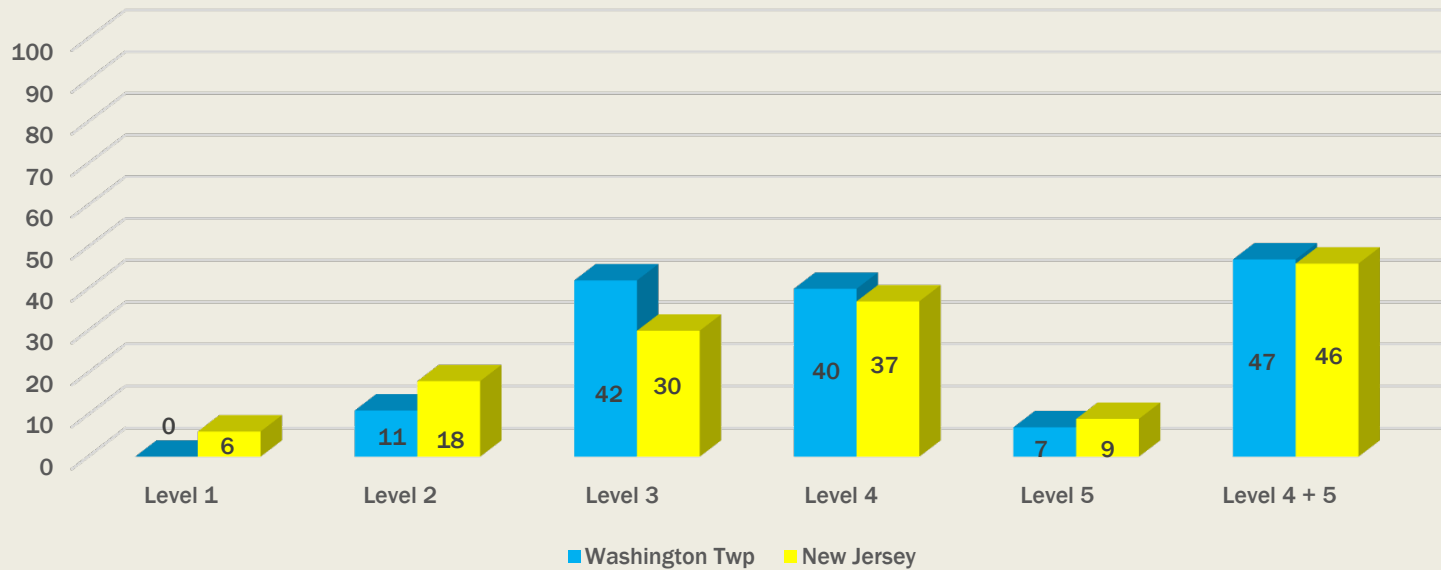

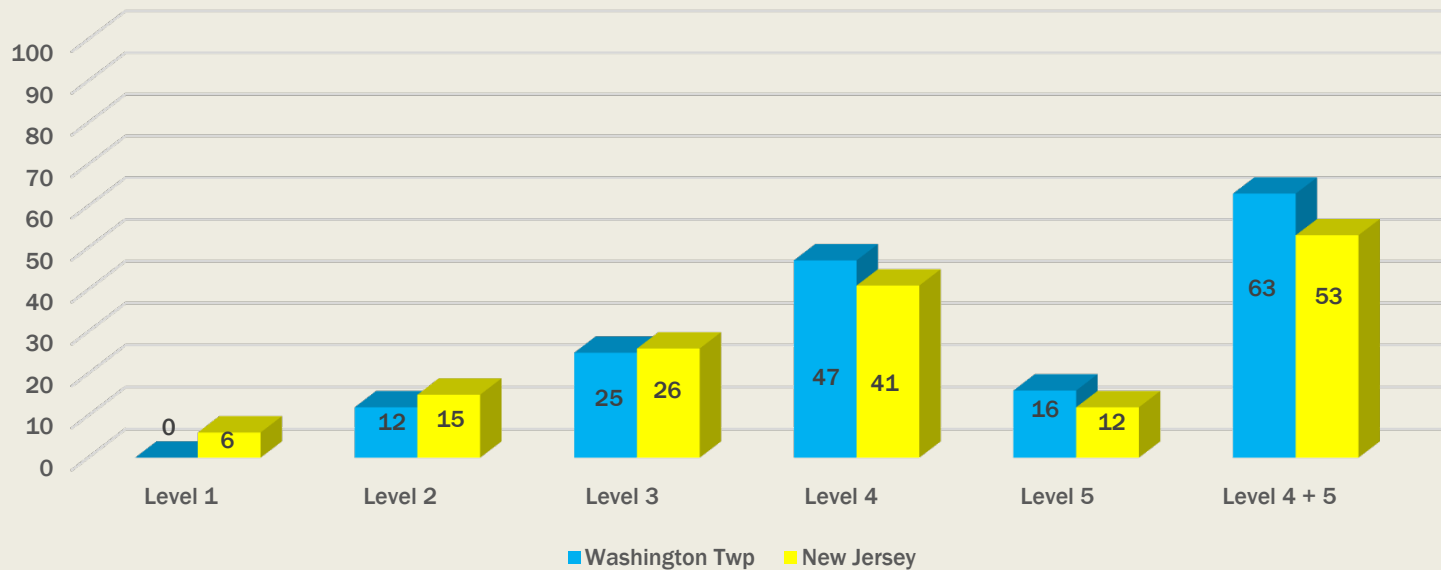

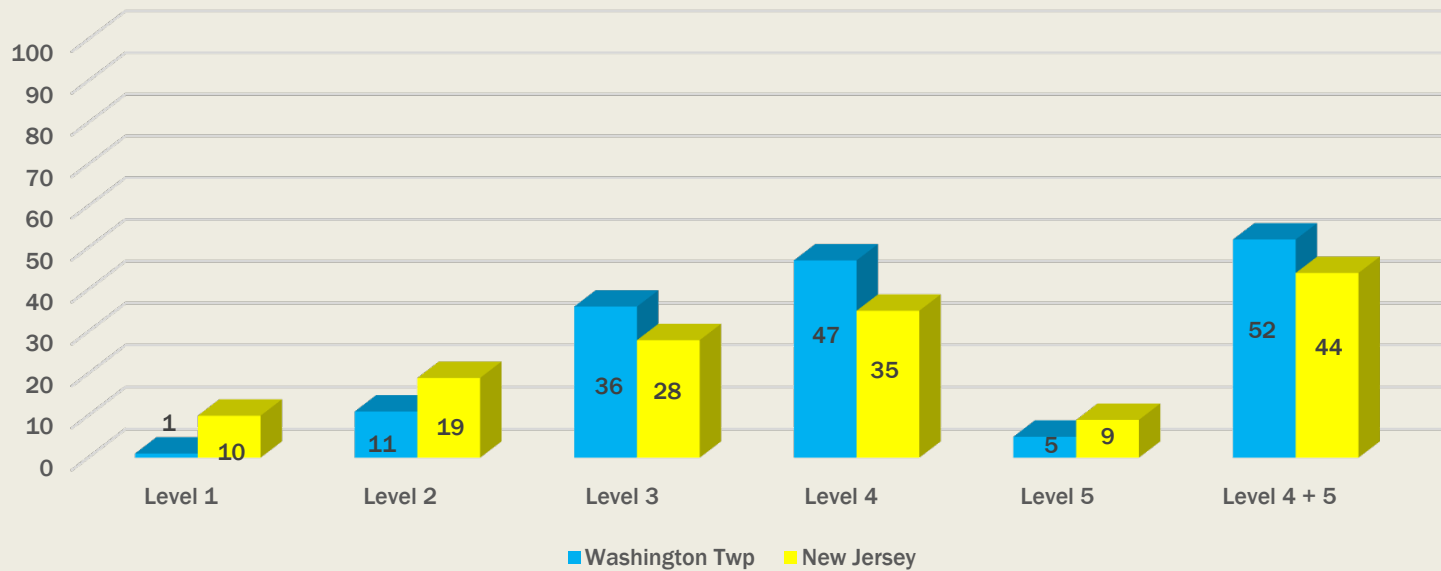

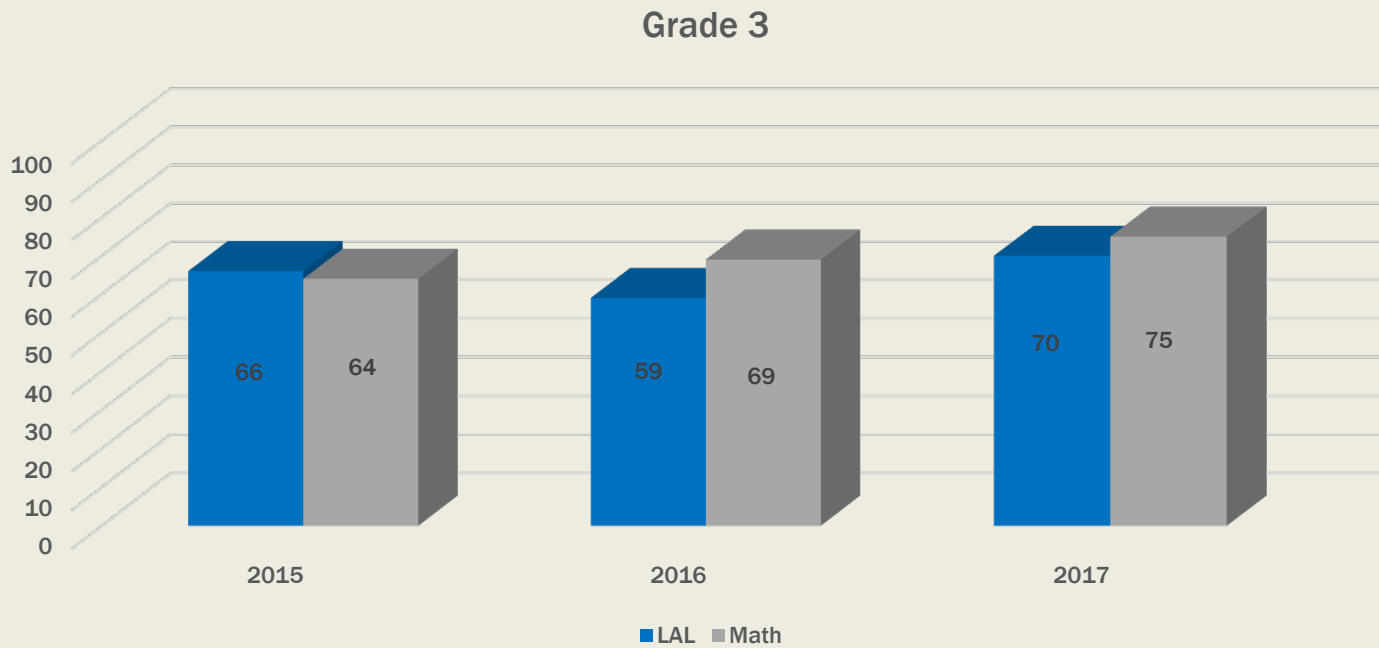

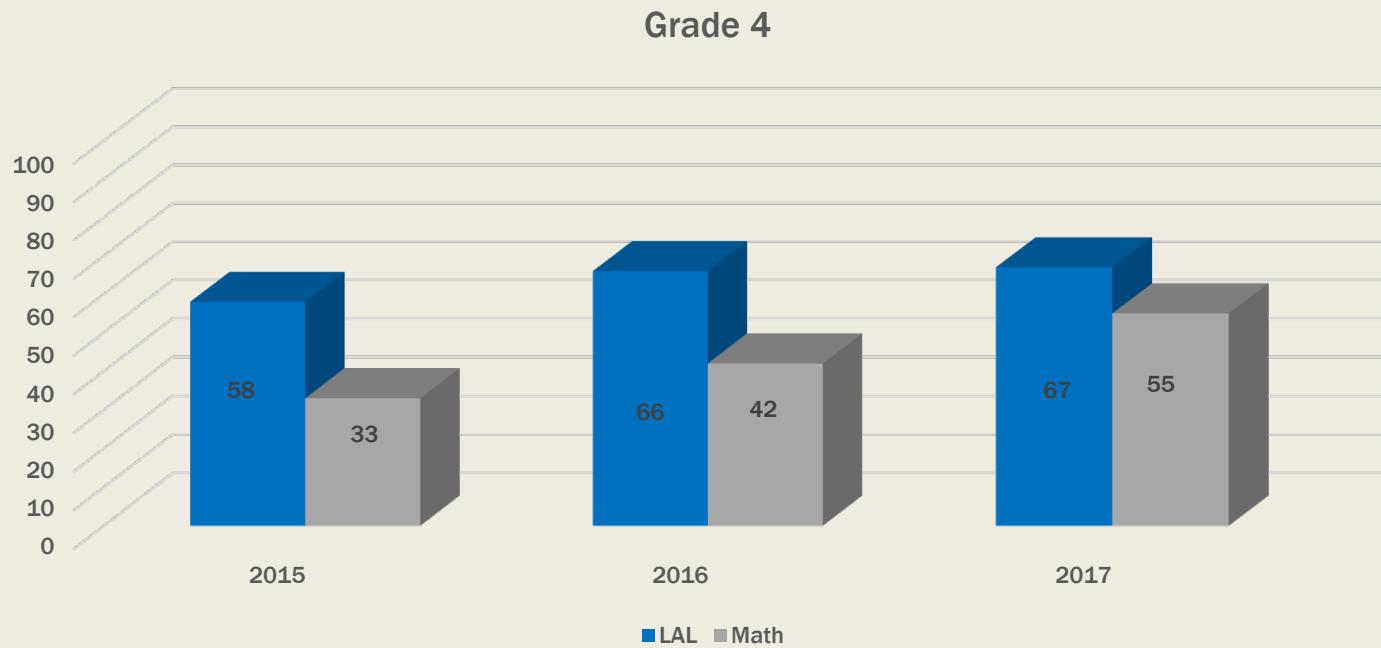

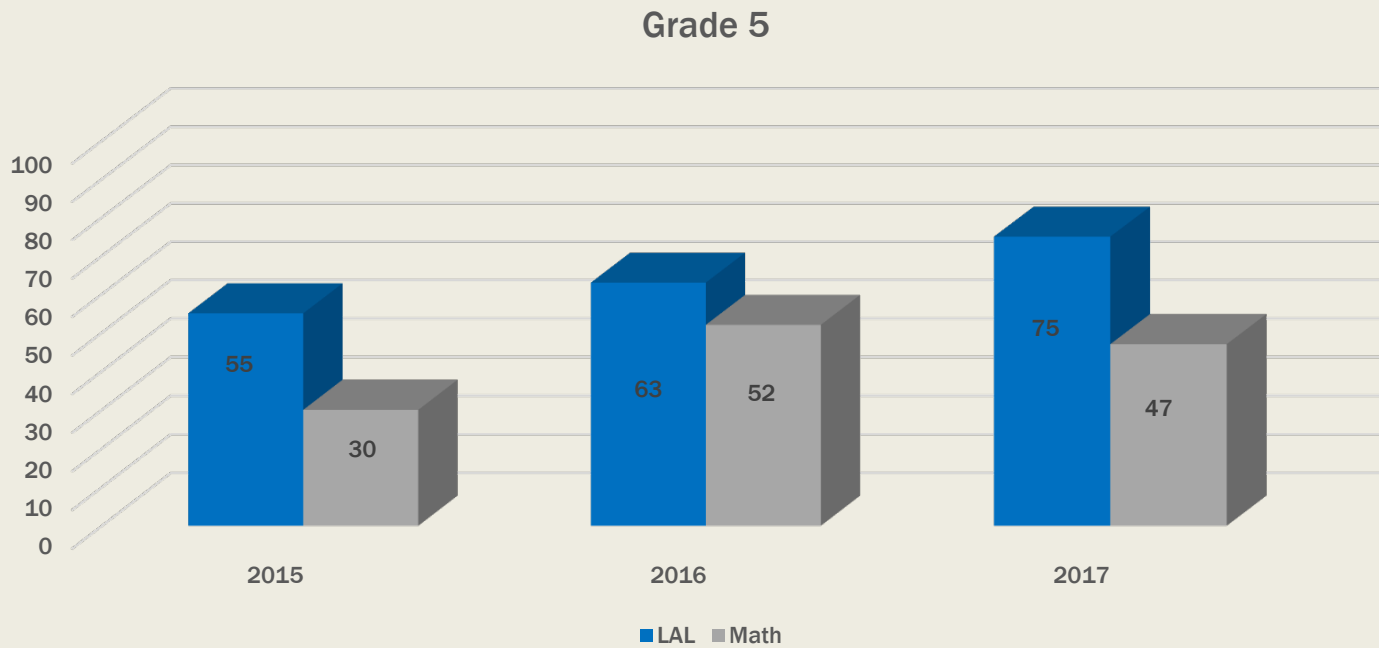

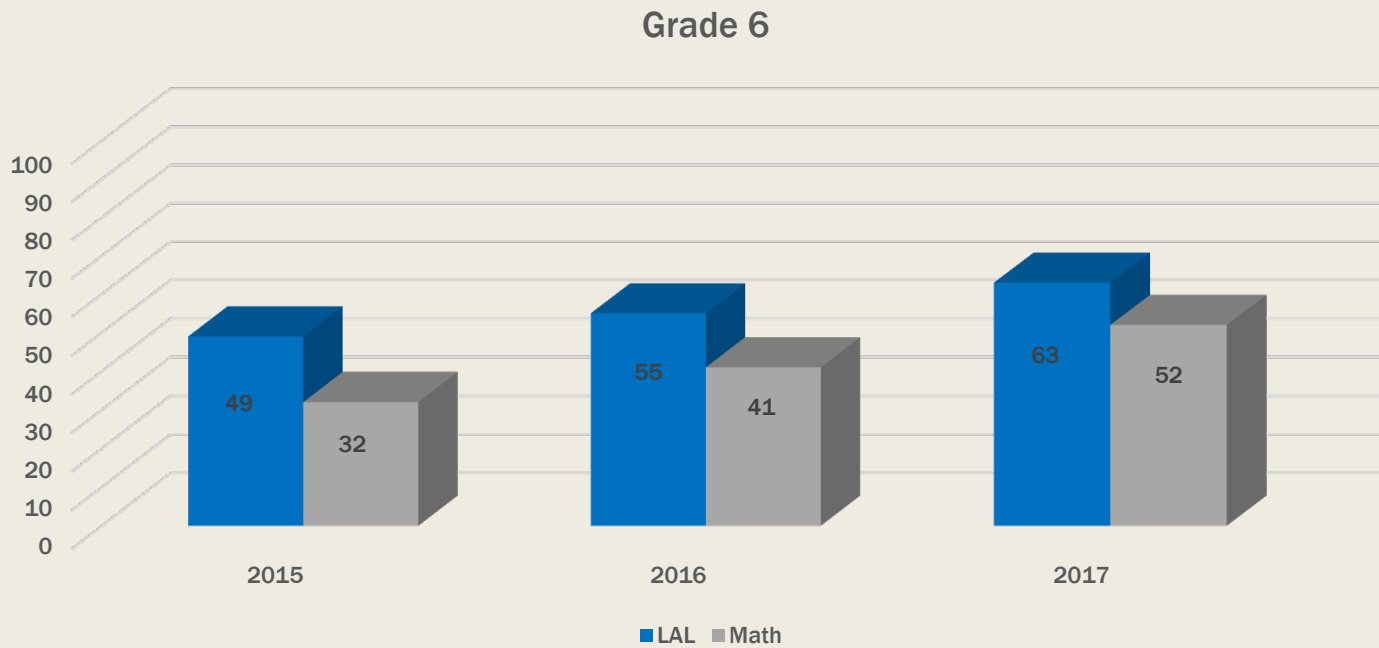

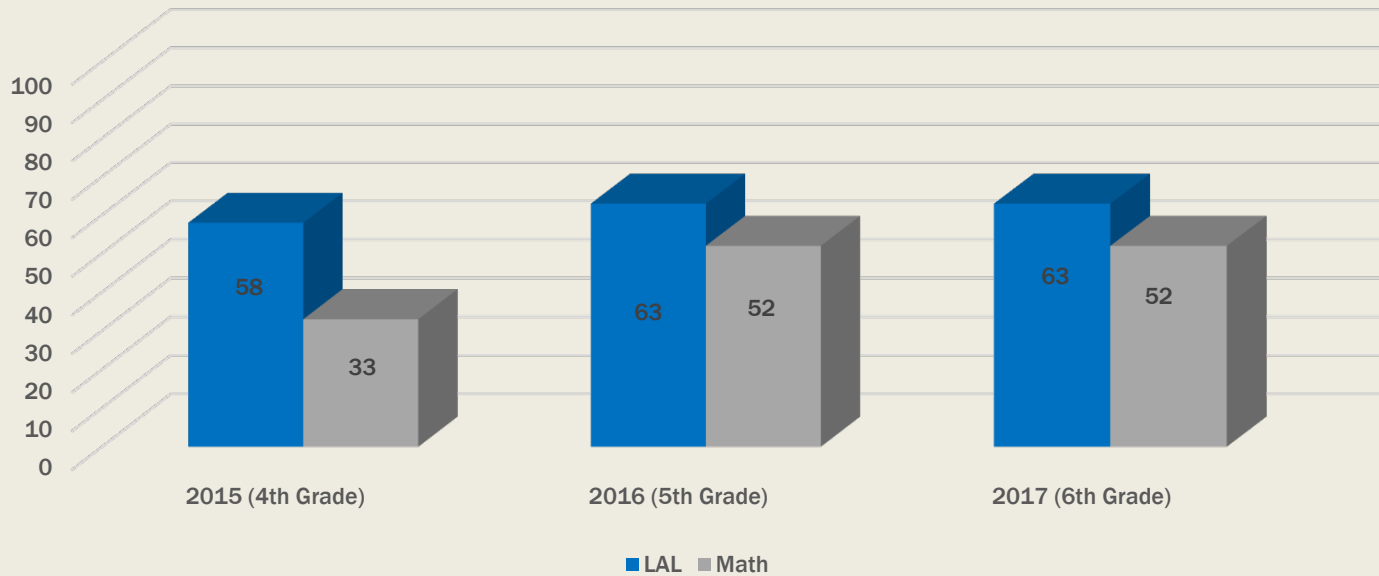

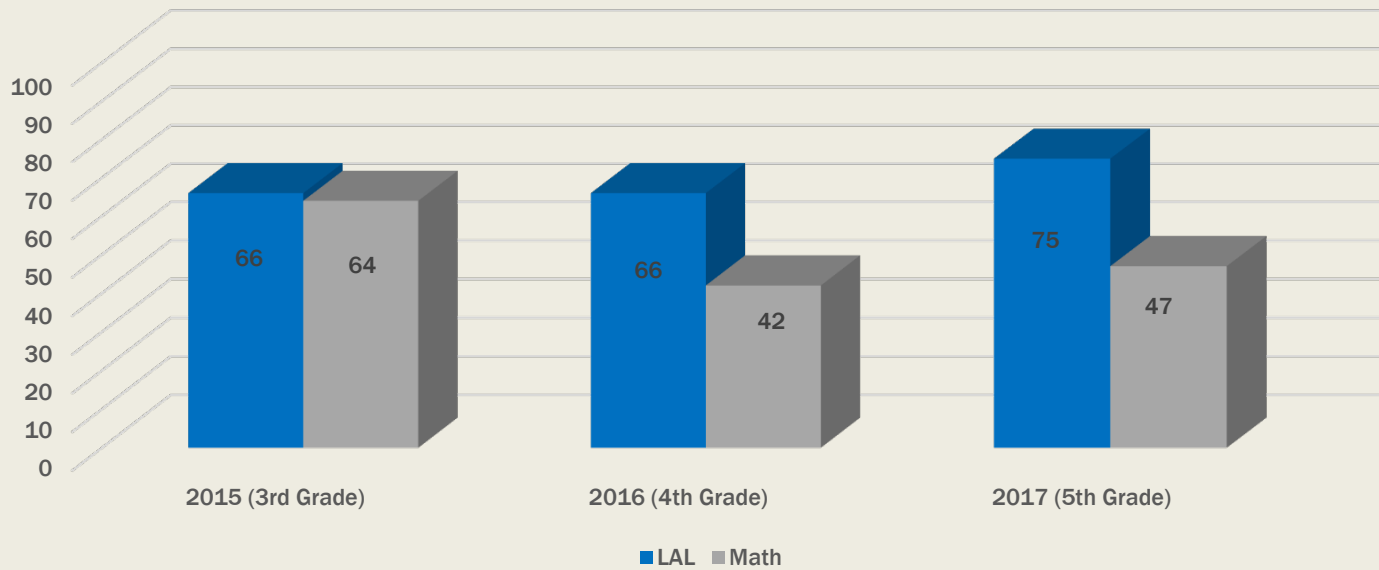

Class of 2017 (current 7th Grade)



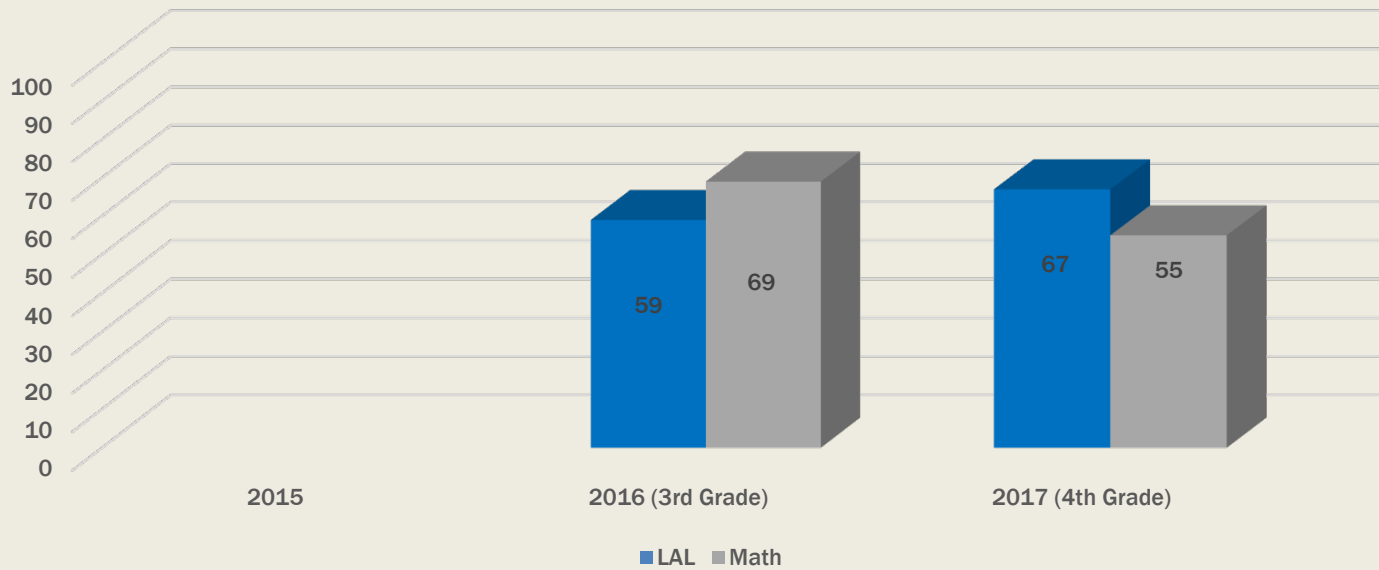
CLASS OF 2018
