In total 217 parents and teachers joined the PTA. If you still wish to join, you can do so through the PTA website store.

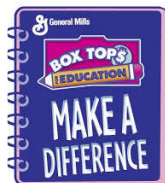
BOX TOPS

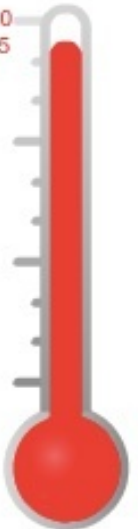
