

This is a haunting announcement that Trunk or Treat will be held on Sunday, October 27th from 6:00-7:00 PM MeadowBreeze Park (Parking Lot and Pavilion)

<u>This event is for all Pre-K thru 3rd Grade Washington Township students, attending Brass</u> <u>Castle/Port Colden Schools. Grades 4th-6th enjoy a separate seasonal event.</u> Staff and faculty are invited to participate as well. Get your costume on and join the fun for a BOO-TIFUL evening with friends and family. Enter your "trunk" into the creativity contest. The event will be held rain or shine. Cider, water, snacks, treat bags, and glow bracelets will be provided by WTPTA. Parents are encouraged to donate baked or store-bought treats. Flashlights and reflective tape on costumes are recommended.

"Trunkers" should prepare for approximately 100 students. You are permitted to hand out any candy/treats you like. (i.e., stickers, tattoos, bubbles, etc.) Families unable to attend or who are "treating" but not "trunking" can donate candy/treats to WTPTA. WTPTA will hand out the candy to our students. Donations may be placed in the orange bins in the schools' lobbies from now until Friday, October 25th. Parents who signed up for PC Seasonal Events will be contacted, but all volunteers are welcome!

What is Trunk or Treat? Trunk or Treat is a lot like tailgating. Several families get together, park their cars in the parking lot, open up the trunks of their cars, and kids come around to each car to Trunk or Treat instead of going house to house to Trick-or-Treat. It is a safe way for our students to have fun and an opportunity for our school community to get together. If you are not "trunking" but would still like to "treat" you will not be able to park in the Meadowbreeze Parking lot near the Pavilion. Parking is available at Brass Castle School, which is a 5 minute walk to the Park and Pavilion.

Schedule is as follows:

5:30-6:00 PM-"Trunkers" are allowed into the parking area and will be given time to decorate their vehicles. For the safety of our children, NO CARS WILL BE PERMITTED TO ENTER THE PARKING LOT AFTER 6:00 PM. NO EXCEPTIONS. Refreshments will be available at the pavilion for the children at this time. Trunks will be judged on creativity. The winner will receive a \$25 Target gift certificate.

6:00-7:00 PM-The students will have a costume parade under the pavilion and then proceed to the vehicles to begin "trunk or treating." IF YOU NEED TO EXIT THE PARKING LOT BEFORE 7:00 PM, PLEASE INFORM A PARKING VOLUNTEER IN ADVANCE.
