

Re: April's Alcohol Awareness Month Contest



Some sobering facts about underage drinking:

- More young people are killed by alcohol than all illegal drugs combined.
- Children who begin drinking alcohol before the age of 15 are 5 times more likely to develop alcohol problems at some point in their life than those who wait until age 21.
- 21% of Warren County Middle School students surveyed (304) have tried alcohol.
- Over 14% of those same students report using alcohol annually
- And 6% of Middle School students ages 12 to 14 when asked have used alcohol within the past 30 days

This year we are sponsoring a public service awareness contest in April (Alcohol Awareness Month), to encourage students to make healthy choices and abstain from underage drinking. This year we are inviting students in grades 4-12 to create a poster highlighting their best message that tells friends and classmates, "Follow me, I choose to be alcohol free".

This contest is meant to educate and reinforce students' healthy choices to abstain from alcohol and other drugs by allowing them to share their own prevention messages. Feel free to incorporate this project into your curriculum.

Please share the attached entry form with students. Students should be as creative as possible. We hope that this will be a positive learning experience for all involved and we look forward to seeing the entries from your school.

POSTER CONTEST GUIDELINES FOR STUDENTS IN GRADES 4-12:

- Poster entries should be created on 8.5"x11" paper (Artwork must come from the student's imagination)
- No copyrighted characters, images, or celebrities may be used or inferred (If you have seen it/him/her on TV, in movies, video games, etc., it can't be used in the entry)
- Entries must be based on the contest's theme
- Students may work with a partner or as a group, but we must receive a permission slip from each contributor.
- Students must submit a completed and signed entry form with their essay or poster
- The deadline for entries to be received is April 25, 2014
- Entries will be picked up at your school by 3pm on April 25th.
