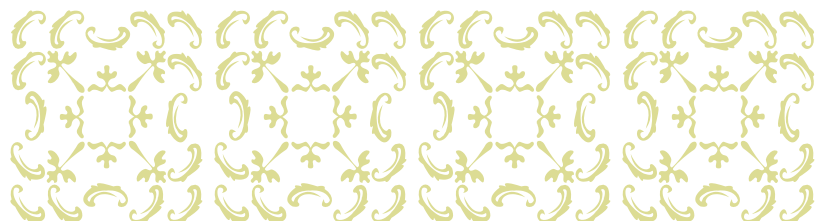

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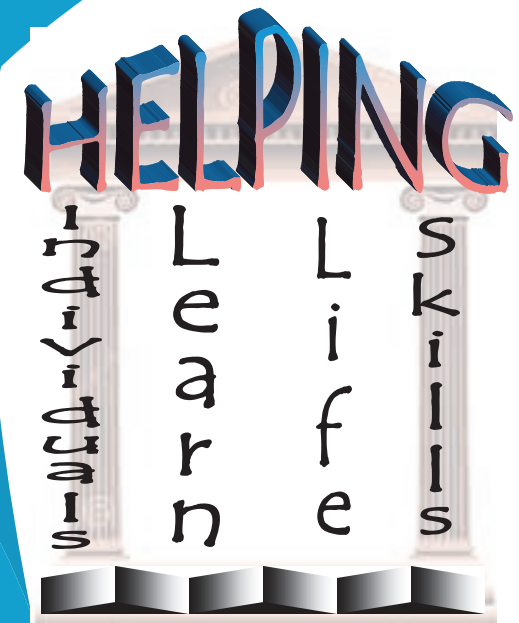

### REALIZING STUDENT POTENTIAL

The **H.I.L.L.S House** is located on Moore St. near the center of Hackettstown, on Centenary College Campus. This multi-story house will include a newly renovated “prep kitchen” with extra counter space to accommodate large group cooking lessons as well as a dining room with an expanded table for social skills luncheons and an open concept living room for group discussions. State of the art laundry facilities and use of the upstairs bedroom will enhance hospitality skill sets. Clerical learning opportunities will also take place upstairs in the office suite. This two story location will allow adequate access for wheelchair bound and limited ambulatory students alike.
