Incoming 2nd – 4th graders: The WTYA offers introductory Field Hockey programs for children in grades 2nd through 6th. The goal is to provide an enjoyable learning experience for all the participants and fans. Our emphasis in this league is to teach the basics of the game, the importance of sportsmanship and team work. Older players are encouraged to mentor the younger players. The win is not the ultimate objective in this level. All players will play a **minimum** of half of each half. **No league standings are kept. Games will be played Sunday afternoons.**

Incoming 5-6th graders: The WTYA offers a level of field hockey that is designed to begin to introduce players to more advanced concepts while not leaving behind new or less experienced players. The field is larger than the 2/4 field to allow for increased creativity and decision-making, but still small enough to accommodate 6 field players and encourage everyone to touch the ball. A goalie and full-size goals have been added, as well as a full-sized scoring circle. The rules of play approach what the players will see in middle school. **Games will be played Sunday afternoons.**

Incoming Kdg & 1st graders: The Micro program will meet at the Brass Castle School fields. The program lasts 4 weeks, **meeting on Saturday mornings**, beginning Sept. 9th at 10:00 am. The WTYA will provide sticks, balls, mouth guards and shirts. The Micro program is run like a clinic as a means to introduce the sport to younger children. There will be a micro play day in October.
