- . 2) Talent audition will be approved. After, each individual will be given a parent permission slip with tryout date for Monday, March 18th **OR** Thursday, March 21st.
- . 3) You must return the parent/guardian permission slip by March 15th.
- . 4) We will only be accepting the top 12 performances/acts, so you need to be prepared. Practice your act with your group! Acts should be about 1.5 minutes to 3 minutes long. Bring your music and all props/costumes to audition.
- . 5) Auditions run from 3:30 - 5:30pm in the GYM. If you are done early you may call your parent/guardian to pick you up early.
- . 6) If you make the Talent Show, practices will be 3:30-5:30 on Monday, April 8th **OR** Tuesday, April 9th. On Monday, April 15th we will hold our dress rehearsal practice from 3:30-5:30 for the whole group.

The Talent Show will be held on **Wednesday @ 6:30pm, April 17, 2019.**
