Tuesday 10/5: EVERYONE COUNTS DAY - Wear clothing with a number on it. Let's focus on acts of kindness one at a time. Everyone deserves to be treated with respect and kindness.

Wednesday 10/6: SCHOOL IS A SAFE PLACE TO BE YOURSELF - Wear your favorite outfit and share your style and personality with others.

Thursday 10/7: STAND UP AGAINST BULLYING - Wear school spirit wear or anything Washington Twp. Our community and school are places we all stand together and support each other.

Friday 10/8: RESPECT FOR ALL LIVING THINGS - This is in coordination with our PTA's spirit day. Dress up as your favorite animal in recognition that all living things deserve respect.
