VISUAL ARTS

All AFA art instructors are provided through a partnership with **Hunterdon Arts Museum**. Class sessions are five (5) weeks, beginning in March. Each class is one and a half hour long.

Jewelry Design (ages 11-14)

Mondays 4:15 - 5:45, Mar 3, 10, 17, 24, 31

Turn beads, wire, chain, found objects and unexpected materials into beautiful handmade jewelry. Learn stringing, knotting, wrapping, crimping, and creative design techniques.

Wearable Art (ages 8 - 10)

Wednesdays 4:15 - 5:45, Mar 5, 12, 19, 26, Apr 2

Make wearable art using felt, fabric, beads, and other fun materials. Children will explore shape, texture, form, and design crafting their own unique belts, bags, t-shirts, and jewelry.

Comics, Manga, Animé (ages 13 - 18)

Wednesdays 4:15 - 5:45, Mar 5, 12, 19, 26, Apr 2

Learn to draw classic comics, plus the styles of Japanese Manga and Animé. Instruction in drawing and inking will be covered, plus games and trivia. From Dragon Ball Z to the X-Men, from Sailor Moon to Spider-Man, this course covers it all. Develop your own characters and learn

to draw your favorites.

Sculpting - Clay and Mixed Media (ages 5 - 9)

Fridays 4:15 - 5:45, March 7, 14, 21, 28, April 4

Working with clay, students will learn the fundamental techniques of coil, slab, and pinch. They will also experiment with size, shape, proportion and design. Finished works can range from a star fish to the Statue of Liberty - all the creative choices are up to you!

Kids & Teens Classes

7-11 YEARS --One and a half hours, twice weekly creativity boosting class where kids learn to stretch their imaginations, think outside the box and use their voices to command attention while working on scenes, monologues, relaxation techniques, and improvisation.

12 & Up- One and a half hour, twice weekly course in basic acting technique, improvisation, relaxation, games and monologue development.

Adult Classes - (18 & Up)

Our adult acting classes* are ongoing and are recommended for students 18 and up who are serious about developing their performance skills. Through technique, scene and monologue study, we will embrace the art of expression and grow together as actors. Classes are offered twice a week, in the late evenings. Students are welcome to attend one or both nights at the same tuition rate.
