Summer vacation is on the way!!!

- Summer is a crucial time in the reading development of your child.
- Research shows that children who do not read over the summer months can lose up to three months of academic growth!
- We encourage you to have your child participate in the "BE A SUPER READER!" reading program, which is designed to prevent summer reading loss.

Our goal is that your child read at least 5 books, or more! The books read need to be logged into the summer reading packet and returned to school in September. One activity per book needs to be completed to receive a "Principal Credit", credits will be used to purchase items at the school store. The "BE A SUPER READER!" reading program is an optional experience for the children. Students will not be penalized for non-participation/completion of the program.

Within this packet you will find more information about the summer reading program. If your child participated in the program last year you are familiar with our program. Please keep these projects and any new projects together to return to school in September 2015 for your child to receive recognition in Principal Points.
