

School Bus Safety

Boarding the Bus

- Arrive early; don't rush
- Line up without pushing
- Stay five big steps away from the curb
- Hold the handrail while you get on the bus

Riding

- Sit down, buckle your seatbelt, stay seated
- Keep your feet in front of you
- Keep your belongings and all of your body inside the seat
- Don't throw anything
- Be courteous and speak softly so the driver can do his/her job

Exiting

- Students in the front should leave first
- Always use the handrails
- If crossing the street, always walk eight big steps in front of the bus and make sure the driver can see you before your cross
- Stop, listen and look both ways
- NEVER walk behind or reach for anything under the bus
