



Warren County Library

Over the summer the library received a question about how students could obtain a library card for use in accessing ebooks and other digital services on our website. There was a concern that some families might not be able to visit the library in person to obtain/renew library cards. We have been working on finding a solution and I am pleased to announce that we have found one. Library card registration can now be done online by submitting the form found at this link: <https://warrenlib.org/content/library-card-registration#.X5GdH9BKiuK>. Once the registration has been approved the library card number and PIN will be emailed so that it can be used right away and the physical card will be mailed. Library cards are initially valid for a period of three months, after which it is necessary to submit valid ID/proof of residency and the card will then be valid for two years. This library card renewal can now also be done online by submitting the form found at this link: <https://warrenlib.org/content/online-card-renewal#.X5GdrtBKiuK>, which also allows ID/proof of residency to be submitted electronically. It is necessary for a parent or guardian to first have a library card to which a minor's card can be linked, and this can also be done using these same forms. We hope that by making access to a library card easier to obtain that more families will be able to make use of library services.
