The Washington Township Police Department is currently accepting applications for the position of Part Time Substitute Crossing Guard, which has a starting salary of \$18.53 per hour. There is a paid training period of approximately 5 weeks, after which, the position is as a substitute to fill in as needed. Frequently, permanent positions become available within a short period of time.

The main objective of this position is to ensure the safety of the school children crossing busy intersections within Washington Borough, Washington Township and Oxford. This would be a great opportunity to enjoy the outdoors and to socialize with a wide array of individuals. The most hours that would be worked during the day would be 2.75, freeing up the rest of your day. The actual times to work vary from town to town. The times for the Guards in Washington Borough are between 7:00 A.M. until 8:45 A.M. and then 2:30 P.M. until 4:00 P.M., depending on the post. The Washington Township Guards are on duty from 8:25 A.M. until 8:55 A.M. and then 3:15 P.M. until 3:45 P.M., and the Oxford duty times are from 7:40 A.M. until 8:40 A.M. and then 2:45 P.M. until 3:30 P.M.
