



# Enrichment and Gifted & Talented (G&T) Selection Appeal Process

If a student is not selected for the Enrichment or Gifted & Talented program, or if there are concerns about the placement decision, an appeal can be made. The appeal process is as follows:

## 1. **Timeframe:**

- Appeals must be submitted within seven (7) days of receiving notification of placement or non-placement in the program.

## 2. **Initial Appeal:**

- Appeals should be made in writing to the building principal.
- The appeal must include additional information that was not previously considered by the Gifted and Talented Coordinator.

## 3. **Review Process:**

- The building principal will review the appeal and the new information provided.
- The principal may consult with the Gifted and Talented Coordinator and other relevant staff members.

## 4. **Decision:**

- The principal will make a decision based on the appeal and communicate it to the parents/guardians.

## 5. **Further Appeal:**

- If parents/guardians are not satisfied with the principal's decision, they may file a further appeal with the superintendent.
- This appeal should also be in writing and include all relevant information.

## 6. **Final Decision:**

- The superintendent will review the case and make a final decision.

Note: It's important to provide any new or additional information that supports the student's eligibility for the program when making an appeal. This could include examples of advanced work, additional test scores, or other relevant evidence of the student's abilities.
