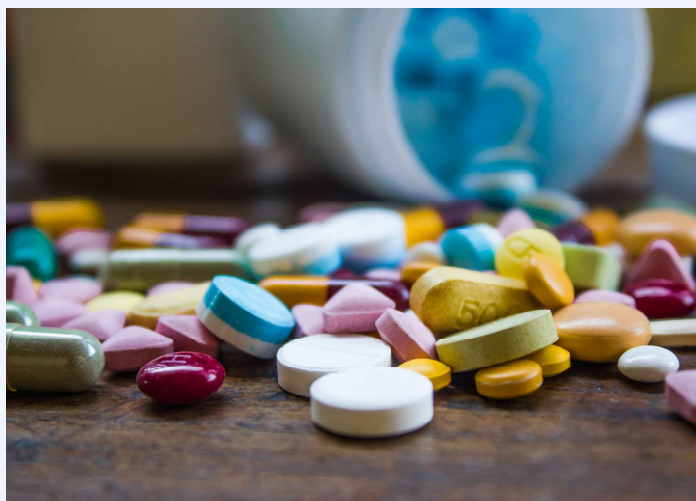


National Prescription Drug Take Back Day Warren County

National Prescription Drug Take Back Day is a nationwide effort led by the U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) that offers a safe, convenient, and responsible way to dispose of unused or expired prescription drugs. In April, 240 locations in New Jersey participated and collected 15,597 pounds of prescription drugs.
