UPDATES AND IMPROVEMENTS:

Over the past few years, WHYBA has been making strides to improve the quality of our program throughout. We are pleased to share with our WHYB Community the following completed upgrades, as well as some of our immediate future plans below.

Mansfield Baseball Fields' Improvements: Brocious and the Minor's field have undergone a complete reconstruction, featuring wider base paths, a new infield mix, new home plate, and a double pitcher's mound. Brocious field has been converted to be used as a dual 46/60, 50/70 field.

Field Equipment Upgrades: We have purchased a new-to-us, used field tractor and drag, a new lining machine, and weighted tarps to cover both the pitcher's mounds and batter's boxes.

Our Future Plans for the Mansfield Fields Include: Upgraded dugouts, adding bleachers, and fixing the scoreboard at Brocious, as well as adding a batting cage for both fields to use. We are currently working with the school to see if we can take down the current foul line fences throughout, to make viewing more enjoyable for all of our families and spectators.
