The Washington Township Police Department is currently accepting applications for the position of Part Time Substitute Crossing Guard that presently has a starting pay of \$20.96 per hour. All training hours are paid for and all equipment is provided. The training period lasts for approximately 5 weeks, and upon completion, the position is as a substitute to cover posts as needed. However, permanent positions become available within a short period of time.

This position must ensure the safety of the school children crossing busy intersections within Washington Borough, Washington Township, and Oxford Township, and it is a great opportunity to enjoy the outdoors and to socialize with a wide array of individuals. All scheduled hours vary from town to town, and the maximum hours that will be scheduled during a workday is 2.75, thereby allowing free time for the rest of your day. Washington Borough Crossing Guard shifts are between 7:00 A.M. until 8:45 A.M. and then 2:30 P.M. until 4:00 P.M., and these times can vary slightly depending on the post being covered for the day. Washington Township Crossing Guard shifts are between 7:55 A.M. until 8:55 A.M. and then 2:45 P.M. until 3:45 P.M. Oxford Township Crossing Guard shifts are between 7:40 A.M. until 8:40 A.M. and then 2:45 P.M. until 3:30 P.M.
